

PRIVACY POLICY Youngbits

This is the Privacy Policy of Youngbits (hereinafter referred to as "Youngbits," "we," "us" or "our"), a company having its address at Radarweg 29, 1043 NX Amsterdam. Youngbits is registered with the Chamber of Commerce under number 37144838. Our Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, share and protect information in relation to our website <https://www.youngbits.com> (the "**Service**"). We collect this information when you visit our website with your computer, tablet or mobile phone ("**Computer**"). We process personal data in a manner that is in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (the "**GDPR**"), the GDPR-based legislation and the other current privacy legislation.

By using the Service, you understand and agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this Privacy Policy. Our Privacy Policy applies to all visitors, users, and others who access the Service ("**Users**").

What kinds of information do we collect?

Information you provide

We collect the following information you provide us with directly:

- a. Your name;
- b. Your phone number;
- c. Your address;
- d. Communications between you and Youngbits (e.g., we may send you Service-related emails);

Log file information

We collect information that your browser sends whenever you visit our Service. This log file information may include information such as your computer's Internet Protocol address, browser type, browser version, the pages of our Service that you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages and other statistics.

Analytics services (non-personally identifiable information only)

We use third-party analytics tools to help us measure traffic and usage trends for the Service. These tools collect information sent by your device or our Service, including the web pages you visit, add-ons, and other information that assists us in improving the Service. The tools use 'cookies', which are text files placed on your device, to collect your log information and behavior information in an anonymous form. We collect and use this analytics information with analytics information from other Users so that it cannot reasonably be used to identify any particular individual User. With respect to Google Analytics, although Google Analytics plants a permanent cookie on your web browser to identify you, the cookie cannot be used by anyone but Google. Google's ability to use and share information collected by Google Analytics about your visits is restricted by the Google Analytics Terms of Use and the Google Privacy Policy. You can prevent Google Analytics from recognizing you on return visits by disabling cookies.

How do we use this information?

We use all of the information we have to help us provide and support our Services. Here is how:

- a. remember information so you will not have to re-enter it during your visit or the next time you visit the Service;
- b. provide, improve, test, and monitor the effectiveness of our Service;
- c. monitor metrics such as total number of visitors, traffic, and demographic patterns;
- d. diagnose or fix technology problems;
- e. develop and test new products and features; and

How is this information shared?

We will not rent or sell your information to third parties outside Youngbits.

Webhosting

Vservs BV

We take web hosting from Vservs BV registered with the Chamber of Commerce under number: 56993803 however our e-mail is separate from web hosting and runs via Gmail / Gsuite. Vservs BV does not process personal data on our behalf and does not use your data for its own purposes if applicable. However, this party can collect metadata about the use of the services. These are not personal data. Vservs BV has taken appropriate technical and organizational measures to prevent loss and unauthorized use of your personal data. Vservs BV is obliged to observe secrecy on the grounds of the agreement.

Invoicing and accounting

Invoiceplane & Cascom Admin

To keep our records up to date, we use the open source application: Invoiceplane. We share your name, address and residence details and details regarding your order / service. This data is used for managing sales invoices. Your personal data is sent and stored protected. Youngbits does not use the personal data in Invoiceplan for purposes other than those described above. For our bookkeeping, we make use of the services of Cascom Admin with its registered office at: Engellaan 2, 1427 AK Amstelhoek registered with the Chamber of Commerce under number: 34261057.

Purpose of processing data

By using our services you leave certain information behind us, for example by creating an account. This may include data such as name, e-mail address, telephone number and payment details. Youngbits collects and processes this data to make our services accessible. We also collect information about your computer (such as IP address and browser type) so that we can improve our services. The personal data will not be provided to third parties, unless Youngbits is required to do so by virtue of the laws or regulations.

We use all the information we collect to:

Change of control

We may also access, preserve and share information when we have a good faith belief it is necessary to: detect, prevent and address fraud and other illegal activity; to protect ourselves, you and others, including as part of investigations; and to prevent death or imminent bodily harm. Information we receive about you may be accessed, processed and retained for an extended period of time when it is the subject of a legal request or obligation, governmental investigation, or investigations concerning possible violations of our terms or policies, or otherwise to prevent harm.

Safety and security

Youngbits has taken appropriate technical and organizational measures by using the latest technologies to protect your information against loss or unlawful processing. We use safeguards to help keep the information collected through the Service secure. However, Youngbits cannot ensure the security of any information you transmit to Youngbits or guarantee that information on the Service may not be accessed, disclosed, altered, or destroyed. We request you to do your part to help us. You are responsible for controlling access to emails between you and Youngbits, at all times. We are not responsible for the functionality, privacy, or security measures of any other organization.

International transfer

Your information may be transferred to, and maintained on computers located outside of your state, province, country or other governmental jurisdiction where the data protection laws may differ than those from your jurisdiction. If you are located outside Netherlands and choose to provide information to us, please note that we transfer the information to The Netherlands. Your consent to this Privacy Policy followed by your submission of such information represents your agreement to that transfer.

Retention period

In accordance with the law, Youngbits does not retain data any longer than is required for attaining the purposes for which they were collected.

Inspection and correction

If you wish to know which of your data Youngbits has recorded or if you wish to amend or remove data that you cannot amend via your account, please contact Youngbits.

Third-party applications, websites and services

We are not responsible for the practices employed by any applications, websites or services linked to or from our Service, including the information or content contained within them. Please remember that when you use a link to go from our Service to another application, website or service, our Privacy Policy does not apply to those third-party applications, websites or services. Your browsing and interaction on any third-party application, website or service, including those that have a link on our Services, are subject to that third party's own rules and policies.

Children's privacy
